EXAMINATION

scanned: no chip found

behavior: fearful, hissing, flinchy, not trying to bite, tries to bolt out

P: 220 R: 40 MM pale white CRT <2s BCS 4/9

Head

Mouth pale white mucus membranes

Nose NSF

Ears NSF

Eyes excoriations around the eyes, OD abrasions

Thorax NSF

Skin maggot infested tail with visible fracture and bone exposure, flea infestation

Abdomen/UG intact male

Musculoskeletal Ambulatory X 4

Nervous system NSF

Periph LN NSF

A: fractured tail

Maggot infestation round the tail

Pale gums, anemia r/o chronic blood loss, inflammation, flea/ectoparasites, etc

Prognosis: guarded

Rec pain meds, capstar and schedule for surgery tomorrow.

TX Convenia, simbadol, capstar

Monitor patient for worsening condition and contact vet if this occurs

9/26:BAR, hisses and tries to run, doesnt try to bite, eating well. FS 4 in littebox. Distal 1/3 of tail has open wound, no maggots seems but is caked with litter and hair. Rec amputation with rescue plea. JC

9/27: BAR, eating well, pending rescue response. Refill off label simbadol use for 3 days. JC
